In Appeal No. 501 of 1864 the Principal Sudder Ameen
of the District of Poona at Poona reversed
the Decree of the M. J. of Justice who had awarded the claim.

A Special Appeal was preferred in the High Court on the grounds that sub-
stantial error in Law in the investiga-
tion of the case, has been made which
has

has produced error in the decision of the
case upon its merits

(a) In that the judge is in error
in holding the provisions of section
I Clause XII of act XIV of 1859 ap=
-plicable to the case.

(b) In that the judge has erro=
-raneously held the decrees Nos 6
and 23 as barring the present suit
the same having been passed on
a different cause of action.

The Court confirms the decree of the Prii.
Sudder Ameen.

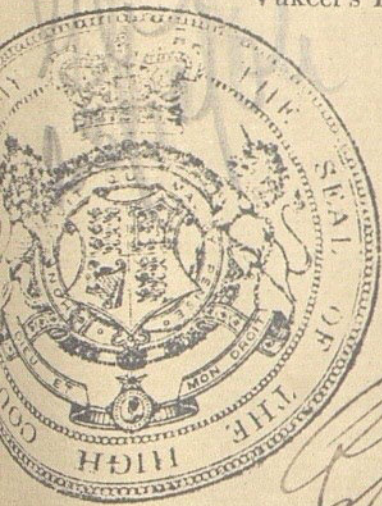
