



Honourable Justice Sir Richard Couch

1866-1870

Sir Richard Couch succeeded as the Chief Justice of Bombay High Court in 1866 . Both Sir Mathew Sausse and Sir Richard Couch held the office of the Chief Justice for comparatively short periods. Sir Couch was transferred from Bombay to Calcutta as Chief Justice in 1870. He was also appointed President of the Commission which tried Malharrao Gaikwad in 1875. After his retirement from India, Couch was appointed a Member of the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council.
