

OFFICE ORDER

IN SUPERCESSION TO THE OFFICE ORDER bearing No. G/3215 dated 20th March 2009:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Office Objections in any Court matter must be removed in the Office, in the concerned department itself and that too in the presence of the concerned Clerk or Officer, and the said official **shall not part with** the file to the Advocates, Clerks or parties-in-person.

THE ADVOCATES AND PARTIES APPEARING IN PERSON ARE HEREBY INFORMED that registers are being maintained by the respective departments for verifying the identity of the person who come to remove office objections. They are, therefore, directed to enter the requisite information in the said registers in order to verify the identity of the person who approached the concerned Officer for removing the Office Objections.


IT IS FURTHER INFORMED THAT in the event the papers viz. Memo of Appeal, Plaint, etc., once filed with the Registry, are taken outside the Court premises for removing Office Objections, then in that event, strict action shall be initiated against the erring party, and the matter will be placed before the concerned Court for appropriate orders.

LASTLY THE ADVOCATES AND PARTIES APPEARING IN PERSON ARE INFORMED that they should refrain from handling/dealing with any of the papers lying on the table of any of the Officer/Clerk without the permission of that Officer/Clerk.

The aforesaid directions should be followed scrupulously for smooth administration, failing which strict action shall be initiated against the erring party and the matter will be placed before the concerned Court for appropriate orders, as stated above.
