The High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad invites sealed quotations from reputed Bidders/Contractors/Agencies for **“the Sale/Auction of old Furnitures/Articles** on **“As is where is basis”** and **“As is what is basis”** as per details given in **Annexure “B”**.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The last date for submission of quotation in the prescribed format is **07/02/2025** up to **5.00 p.m.**
- 2) The Scrap material will be sold on **as is where is condition**. No Claim query/dispute will be entertained in this regard after submission of quotation.
- 3) The bidder shall quote the amount in Rupees for whole lot of old furnitures/articles as per the details mentioned at Annexure-“B”, in the sealed quotation by indicating on the Envelope **“Quotation for purchase of old Furnitures/Articles”**.
- 4) The award of Auction/The items shall be sold to the bidder whose offer will be the affordable highest price.
- 5) The Bidder must not have been blacklisted by Central/State

Government, Corporations or Government undertakings. Undertaking to that effect must be submitted by the bidder.

6) The old Scrap material is available for inspection on any working day between 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. before the last date of submission of quotations, in coordination with a responsible officer/official from the Protocol Department of this Registry.

7) The prescribed form/Price Bid for submitting the quotations is in **Annexure- “A”** and details of old furnitures/articles to be auctioned in **Annexure “B”** which may be downloaded from website: <https:bombayhighcourt.nic.in>.

8) All materials will be auctioned as a single lot to the successful bidder, and no partial bids will be entertained. If the quoted rates of the H1 bidder are lower than the upset value provided by the PWD Department, the tender will be canceled.

9) The bidders should submit a **Tender Fee for Rs.500/- [non-refundable]** and EMD for **Rs.5,000/-** by Demand Drafts of any Nationalized Bank drawn in favor of Registrar (Admin.), High Court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad, payable at Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar with the quotation. The quotation without Tender Fee and EMD Shall be summarily rejected.

10) The EMD of the unsuccessful bidder will be returned and that of successful bidder shall be returned after the successful completion of the work. If the successful bidder fails to lift/carry the articles from this office within Five (05) days from the receipt of the work order, the EMD amount of Rs.

5,000/- shall be forfeited.

11) The interested bidders may submit the price bid duly stamped and signed on the letter head of bidder in a Sealed Envelope along with Demand Drafts and photocopies of relevant documents i.e. Shop Act License, PAN Card, GST and Annexure "C" with sign and seal etc.

12) It shall be presumed that, the bidders have fully inspected the old/unused/Beyond repairable old furnitures, before submitting their tenders. The Registry shall not be responsible and shall not entertain any complaint in this regard after submission of quotation.

13) The items once sold to the successful bidder shall not be taken back on any condition whatsoever.

14) The Registry will issue work order in favor of successful bidder in respect of auction of old furnitures/articles.

15) The successful bidder shall pay the entire quoted amount by Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank within 24 hours of receiving the work order from the office of the Registrar (Administration), High Court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad. After clearance of the said Demand Draft, they may proceed further for lifting the old furniture/articles from this office at their own cost. The time limit for removal of the auctioned materials shall be Five (05) from the date of receipt of the work order.

16) While carrying the articles, care shall be taken not to create nuisance in the premises of the Hon'ble High Court.

17) The bidder/contractor/agency shall be responsible for taking all

necessary permissions from the competent authority of High Court Bench at Aurangabad.

18) The scrap furnitures/articles shall be lifted from the site by the successful bidder at its own cost. The cost on this account shall be deemed to be included in the quoted offer.

19) Any damage caused by the workmen of the contractor to wall, ceilings, floors fixtures etc should be made good at the contractor's cost.

20) The undersigned reserves the right to adjourn or cancel or modify the terms of auction with or without notice and will not be responsible for any loss or inconvenience caused to anyone in this regard.

21) The decision of the High Court Registry in the qualification criteria and selection of bidder shall be final and binding on participated bidders. No correspondence will be entertained outside the process of negotiation / discussion with the High Court Registry.

Note: The High of Court Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad reserves the right to waive any minor informality or non-conformity or irregularity in the tender.

22) The High Court of Bombay Bench at Aurangabad reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation, cancel the tendering process at any stage and reject all Bids at any time, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for Tendering Authority's action.

23) Arbitration :- In the event of any dispute or difference arising out or

touching upon any of the terms and conditions of this contract and / or in relation to the implementation or interpretation thereof, the same shall be resolved initially by mutual discussion and conciliation but in the event of failure thereof, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitrator appointed by High Court Registry. The arbitration shall be at Aurangabad and the Arbitrator shall give his award in accordance with “The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996”. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the parties.

24) Legal Jurisdiction :-

Legal dispute, if any, shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Aurangabad Court, in Maharashtra State only.
