

CIRCULAR

At the time of hearing the Tax Appeals, the Hon'ble Division Bench noticed that in Tax Appeals, Appellant does not annex Certified True Copy of impugned Order of Appellate Tribunal duly certified by the Tribunal and merely annexes illegible, incomplete photocopies of the impugned order and certified as True Copy by Advocate on record.

In view of the above it is hereby notified for the information of the Advocates and parties appearing in-person that in all Tax Appeals, at the first place, Certified True Copy of impugned Order of Appellate Tribunal duly certified by Tribunal should be annexed and secondly, if for any reason, such certified true copy cannot be annexed, then legible, complete photocopy of such certified copy duly certified by Tribunal to be annexed and in the event, such certified copy cannot be annexed, Appellant shall state the reasons as to why certified copy as above cannot be annexed, and then only legible, complete photocopy of such certified copy duly certified as true copy by Advocate on record to be annexed.
