THE HIGH COURT OF JUDICATURE AT BOMBAY

APPELLATE SIDE

NOTIFICATION

No. Rule/0705/2023.- In exercise of the powers conferred under article 227 and 235 of the Constitution of India, the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice and the Judges of the Bombay High Court are pleased to direct that the following amendment shall be made in the Civil Manual :-

(I)

Rule 4 of Appendix A, Paragraph 577 (iii) of Civil Manual be substituted as follows :-

“The number of candidates to be enlisted annually in such category specified in rule (1) shall be such as to make the total number in each category equal to the number of existing vacancies sought to be filled up. It may also indicate the number of vacancies that are expected to arise in the next two years. In case the expected vacancies are indicated, the selection process shall be conducted for filling up both existing and expected vacancies.”.

(II)

In rule 6(a) of Appendix A, Paragraph 577 (iii) of Civil Manual, insert the words “as per rule 4” after the words “to be enlisted” and before the words “shall be advertised”.

(III)

Rule 7(a) of Appendix A, Paragraph 577 (iii) of Civil Manual is substituted as follows :-

(a) The Committee shall fix the seniority of each selected candidate on merit and merit being equal on age and prepare a select list of candidates in separate parts as provided in rule 1. The select list shall consist of names of candidate equal to the number of vacancies notified as per Rule 4, arranged in order of merit. If considered necessary, a wait list of the candidates, arranged in order of merit, may be prepared not exceeding twenty five percent of the total number of vacancies notified. Such list(s) so prepared shall be signed and dated by the members of the Recruitment Committee and shall ordinarily be valid for a period of two years from the date of its notification as above.

Provided that the Chief Justice may, in his discretion, direct the appointment from those list(s) even after expiry of the period of two years until a new list is prepared in accordance with the rules.

(IV)

In Rule 8, Appendix A, Paragraph 577(iii) of Civil Manual,

1. sub-rule (i) of the post of Stenographer, be deleted.
2. sub-rule (ii-b) of the post of Stenographer (Lower Grade), be substituted as follows and renumbered as sub-rule (i) :—

(i) Stenographer : Grade-3 :

Eligibility Criteria :-

(I) Qualification : A candidate for being eligible;

(a) Must possess Degree from any recognized University.

(b) Adequate knowledge of the regional language of the Court in the District.

(c) Qualify Government Commercial Certificate Examination or examination conducted by Government Board or Government Certificate in Computer Typing Basic Course (GCC-TBC or I.T.I.) for speed of 100 w.p.m. or above in English Shorthand and minimum

English Typing speed of 40 w.p.m. and 80 w.p.m. Marathi Shorthand speed and Marathi Typing speed of 30 w.p.m.

(d) Possess Computer Certificate about proficiency in operation of word processor in Windows and Linux in addition to M.S. Office, M.S. Word, Wordstar-7 and Open Office Org. obtained from any of the following Institutes :

- a) Statutory Universities in the State of Maharashtra or Goa, as the case may be.
- b) Maharashtra or Goa State Board of Technical Education, as the case may be.
- c) NIC
- d) DOEACC
- e) APTECH
- f) NIIT
- g) C-DAC
- h) DATAPRO
- i) SSI
- j) BOSTON
- k) CEDIT
- l) MS-CIT
- m) Certificate regarding qualification of computer knowledge issued by the Government of Maharashtra or Goa, as the case may be.

(II) Candidate should not have more than two living children born after 28.03.2006.

(III) Candidate should not have been arrested or convicted for any offence and he/she should disclose pendency of Criminal Case / Complaint or decided case against him/her.

3. sub-rule (ii-a) of the post of Stenographer (Higher Grade), be substituted as follows and renumbered as sub-rule (ii) :

(ii) Stenographer Grade-1 and 2 : Minimum English shorthand speed of 120 words per minute, Marathi shorthand speed of 80 words per minute, minimum English typing speed of 40 words per minute, and Marathi typing speed 30 words per minute.

4. sub-rule (ii-c) of the post of Steno-Typist, be deleted.

5. Eligibility Criteria specified for the post of Clerks at sub-rule (i), (ii) and (iii) be substituted as follows :

Junior Clerks :

- (I) Qualification : A candidate for being eligible ;
 - (a) Must possess Degree from any recognized University.
 - (b) Adequate knowledge of the regional language of the Court in the District.

(c) Must have passed Government Commercial Certificate Examination or examination conducted by Government Board or Government Certificate in Computer Typing Basic Course (GCC-TBC or I.T.I.) for speed of 40 w.p.m. English Typing and speed of 30 w.p.m. in Marathi Typing.

(d) Possess Computer Certificate about proficiency in operation of word processor in Windows and Linux in addition to M.S. Office, M.S. Word, Word star-7 and Open Office Org. obtained from any of the following Institutes :

a) Statutory Universities in the State of Maharashtra or Goa, as the case may be.

b) Maharashtra or Goa State Board of Technical Education, as the case may be.

c) NIC

d) DOEACC

e) APTECH

f) NIIT

g) C-DAC

h) DATAPRO

i) SSI

j) BOSTON

k) CEDIT

l) MS-CIT

m) Certificate regarding qualification of computer knowledge issued by the Government of Maharashtra or Goa, as the case may be.

(II) Candidate should not have more than two living children born after 28.03.2006.

(III) Candidate should not have been arrested or convicted for any offence and he/she should disclose pendency of Criminal Case / Complaint or decided case against him/her.

6. Post and eligibility criteria for the post of English Section Writer be deleted.

7. Post and eligibility criteria for the post of Regional Language Section Writer be deleted.

8. Eligibility Criteria for the post of Peon be substituted as follows :

Peon/Hamal :

(I) Qualification : A candidate for being eligible ;

a) A candidate must have passed minimum 7th Standard examination and having good physique.

(II) Candidate should not have more than two living children born after 28.03.2006.

(III) Candidate should not have been arrested or convicted for any offence and he/she should disclose pendency of Criminal Case / Complaint or decided case against him/her.

(V)

Rule 9, Appendix A of Paragraph 577(iii) of Civil Manual be substituted as under :

Age Limit -The age limit for all posts should not be less than 18 years and more than 38 years of age in case of General Category and 43 years in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Class or Special Backward Class as specified by the Government.

(VI)

In Paragraph 578(i) of Chapter XXXI of Civil Manual, substitute the words “10th Standard” in place of words “Standard VIIth”.
