The Main Written Examination of the provisionally eligible candidates for the post of District Judge, by nomination, will be conducted on **Saturday, 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 and Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2024** **at Mumbai centre only i.e. at Government Law College, 'A' Road, Churchgate, Mumbai 400 020.** The main written examination shall comprise of two papers based on Civil Law and Criminal Law carrying 100 marks each, having duration of 3 hours each i.e. from 11.00 a.m. to 02.00 p.m.

The provisionally eligible candidates for the main written examination must submit original documents alongwith attested copies for scrutiny / verification as per the **Clause No. 3 of the advertisement** and they are requested to report on **22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2024 and 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2024** on the scheduled date & time for scrutiny / verification of original documents alongwith attested copies in the office of the Registrar (Legal and Research), High Court, Appellate Side, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Annexe Building, Mumbai – 400 032 (referred at Sr. No. 2 above).

On-line link will be provided shortly to the provisionally eligible candidates through E-mail and SMS to download from website of the High Court, the “Admit Cards” and “Instructions to Candidates” for the main written examination. The downloaded copy of the admit card will be considered valid to appear for the above examination. Please note that admit cards will not be sent by post.
