

## NOTICE

**IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED** for the information of the Advocates and the parties appearing in person **at the Principal Seat at Bombay** that the **Single Bench presided over by the Hon'ble Shri Justice Arif S. Doctor** has issued the following directions **w.e.f. Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2025** :

1. Matters shall be listed as per following schedule:

		(B)	Administration Suits and Partition Suits
		(C)	Commercial Disputes of value of Rs. 100 Crores or more

		(E)	Appeals under the Companies Act, except part-heard matters of other Courts
2	<b>Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday</b>		Testamentary matters

2. No mentioning is allowed unless there is an extreme urgency, which cannot wait till the assigned date. Such urgency must be made out in the praecipe itself and to be **mentioned at 10.30 am only**. If it is found that

there is no urgency, costs may be imposed.

3. For circulation of matters, Advocates and Parties appearing in person shall submit one page typed praecipe (in proper font) to the Associate of the Court strictly before 10.30 a.m. The seriatim praecipe should be in the following format :

- a. Date of Filing of the Petition / Suit
- b. The last date of listing
- c. The next date of listing
- d. The Week Day as per allocation
- e. The category of matter
- f. purpose for which circulation sought
- g. The urgency in brief

4. Advocates and Parties appearing in person are directed to provide their appearances in typed format only and if not given, their names will not be included in the order sheet. No application for speaking to the minutes to correct/include appearances will be entertained in that case.

5. The matters need not be mentioned for continuation of interim / ad-interim relief, already granted, and that the interim / ad-interim relief granted earlier, shall stand continued automatically till the next date, in the case of :

- (a) In matters, which are not called out, though listed;
- (b) When the Board is discharged, due to paucity of time;
- (c) Non-availability of the Court for judicial work; and
- (d) Matters not listed on due date.
