

## **NOTICE**

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for the information of Advocates and the Parties appearing in person **at the Principal Seat at Bombay** that the Single Bench presided over by **the Hon'ble Shri Justice Arif S. Doctor** has issued the following directions with effect from **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 :-**

**A. The matters shall be listed as per the following schedule :**

After completion of Daily Board on every Thursday and Friday, final hearing of Petitions under Section 34 and 37 on weekly board will be taken up.

B. If required, on any day, there may be a short supplementary board of not more than 8 to 10 matters.

C. If Arbitrator is to be appointed by consent of the parties, the details of Arbitrator viz. name, address, contact details and email address must be provided at the time of hearing of the matter itself.

D. Advocates and Parties appearing in person are directed that for circulation of matters they shall submit one page typed praecipe (in proper font) to the Associate / Sheristedar of the Court strictly before 10.30 a.m. The seriatim praecipe should be in the following format :

- a. Date of Filing of the Petition
- b. The last date of listing
- c. The next date of listing
- d. The Week Day as per allocation
- e. Section of the Petition / Application
- f. The urgency in brief

E. No mentioning is allowed unless there is an extreme urgency which cannot wait till the assigned date. Such urgency must be made out in the praecipe itself and to be mentioned **at 10.30 a.m. only**. If it is found that there is no urgency, costs may be imposed.

F. Advocates and Parties appearing in person are directed to provide their appearances in typed format only and if not given, their names will not be included in the order sheet. No application for speaking to the minutes to correct /include appearances will be entertained in that case.

G. The matters need not be mentioned for continuation of interim / ad-interim relief, already granted, and that the interim / ad-interim relief granted earlier, shall stand continued automatically till the next date, in the case of :

- (a) In matters, which are not called out, though listed;
- (b) When the Board is discharged, due to paucity of time;
- (c) Non-availability of the Court for judicial work; and
- (d) Matters not listed on due date.
