THE ADVOCATES AND PARTIES APPEARING IN-PERSON are hereby put to notice that His Lordship Shri Justice K.R. Shriram is pleased to issue directions to the Appellate Side Registry for issuance of following Notice :-

- (A) Advocates/ Petitioners appearing in-person in Arbitration petitions under Section 11, are hereby directed to serve the copy of the petition alongwith notice intimating next CMIS date assigned by the Registry to the Respondent/s immediately after getting registration number for the matter without awaiting order from Court to serve. The notice shall also state that the Court may dispose the petition finally in the first hearing itself.
- (B) All such petitions/notices shall be served through private service, i.e. either by speed post, courier with acknowledgment due, hand delivery and through E-mail ID.
- (C) Where respondent is a Company, service of such notice shall be effected on the addresses mentioned in the cause title of the petition, so also on the registered address mentioned in the MCA (Ministry of Corporate Affairs) website, i.e mca.gov.in. Furthermore, they shall also to serve the notice upon the respondent on E-mail ID of respondent Company as recorded in MCA Website.
- (D) Advocates and parties appearing in-persons are further directed that before the next date fixed by the CMIS they shall file affidavit of service or such affidavits can be kept ready with them to be tendered across the bar at the time of first hearing.
