IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for the information of the Advocates and the parties appearing in-person at the **Principal Seat at Bombay** that the Single Bench presided over by the **Hon'ble Shri. Justice Prithviraj K. Chavan** has issued the following directions w.e.f. **Monday, 13th January, 2025** :

“Advocates and parties-in-person are requested to follow the following instructions :-

(a) The praecipes for urgent circulation shall be given to the Sheristedar **a day earlier, before 11.00 a.m.** The praecipes shall prominently mention the category of the matters such as ; (i) Criminal Applications u/s 482 of Cr.PC./528 of BNSS, CRA and Cr. Writ Petitions relating to Crime against Women and Children (except those assigned to other Courts), (ii) Criminal Appeals against conviction as well as appeals against acquittal etc.

(b) The praecipes shall contain the date of the impugned order, if any, the date of filing of the petition/ application, subject matter in brief and the urgency in the matter.

(c) Upon perusal of the praecipes, the Court will grant dates accordingly.

(d) In case of due matters, other than fresh petitions / applications, the praecipe will specify the date assigned to the matters and specific urgency in the context of the date assigned.

(e) Praecipe without the aforesaid details will not be considered as properly submitted praecipe, and no cognizance thereof will be taken.

(f) The matters need not be mentioned for continuation of interim / ad-interim relief, already granted, and that the interim / ad-interim relief granted earlier, shall stand continued automatically till the next date, in case of ;

- (i) Non-availability of the Court for judicial work ;
- (ii) In the matter curtailed from the Board ;
- (iii) In the matter which are not called out, though listed ;
- (iv) When the Board is discharged, due to paucity of time ; and
- (v) In case, the matters are not shown on the Board on the scheduled dates.
