

N O T I C E

All concerned Advocates and parties appearing in person are hereby informed that the following directions are issued by **the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Amit Borkar** for the purposes of streamlining the listing and hearing of bail applications before His Lordship. These directions shall come into effect from **Monday, 9th June 2025**, and remain in force until further orders:

1. No mentioning of matters, including bail applications, shall be permitted before the Court. Advocates and parties are required to strictly adhere to the circulation procedure as laid down herein.
2. Bail applications shall be considered for circulation for the immediately succeeding week without the need for oral mentioning.
3. The circulation note shall mandatorily include the following details:
 - a) The highest offence alleged against the applicant.
 - b) The maximum punishment prescribed for the said offence.
 - c) The duration of custody of the applicant as on the date of circulation.
 - d) Circulation notes not containing the above details shall be rejected.
4. The Office shall ensure that the bail applications are evenly distributed throughout the following week for effective listing and disposal.
5. In cases where service of notice has not been effected upon the Public Prosecutor or other concerned parties, and a request for adjournment is made by the Public Prosecutor, the matter shall ordinarily be adjourned.

6. Where interim or ad-interim relief has already been granted in a bail matter and:

- The matter is adjourned by consent of parties, or
- The matter is not reached due to paucity of time,

then such interim or ad-interim relief shall continue until the next date.

7. Mentioning for continuation of interim or ad-interim relief already granted in matters on the board shall not be entertained.
