1. **(Any one)** : Electricity Bill, Telephone Bill, Mobile Bill, House Rent Receipt, Bank's Postal Pass Book, Agreement of the premises, ⁿMo^hthwise (Monthly) rent, lease, passport, ration card, certificate from the Superintendent if stays in hostel, home for aged etc.

2. **Proof of age** : School Leaving Certificate / Pan Card / Bona fide Certificate / Birth Certificate etc.

3. Latest Passport size colour photo (Size 3.5 cm x 3.5 cm)


