IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for the information of the Advocates and the parties appearing in-person at the **Principal Seat at Bombay** that the Division Bench presided over by the **Hon'ble Shri Justice A. S. Chandurkar and the Hon'ble Shri Justice M. M. Sathaye** has issued the following directions regarding assignment **w.e.f. Monday, 6th January 2025** :

1. No mentioning of matters for circulation is permitted. Only matters of extreme urgency which cannot wait, can be mentioned for circulation.
2. In regard to other matters which may not involve extreme urgency, the Advocates and Parties-in-person are requested to submit one page typed praecipe to the Associate / Sheristedar of the Court strictly between 10.15 a.m. to 10.25 a.m. The dates of circulation will be published on the High Court website on the very day in the evening. The seriatim praecipe should be in the following format :
 - i. The urgency :
 - ii. Date of the impugned order, if any :
 - iii. Date of Filing :
 - iv. Act Name :
 - v. Next scheduled listing date :
 - vi. Extreme urgency to list matter
before scheduled listing date :
 - vii. Three alternative preferred dates :
3. Strict instructions are given to the Board Department to list the matters pertaining to the assignment of this Court chronologically / as per their turn unless permitted / directed by the Court specifically.

4. Advocates / Parties-in-person are requested not to interrupt the Court Proceeding once the Daily Board begins and mention their matters which are on board. Mentioning of matters at 1.30 p.m. or 2.30 p.m. on any day is strictly not allowed.
5. Advocates are requested to provide their appearances in typed format only and if not given, their names will not be included in the order sheet. It is observed that this is not being followed largely and it results in extreme difficulty to the Department and the Court to decipher the handwriting, names and spellings while passing orders. No application for speaking to minute to correct / include appearances will be entertained in such cases.
6. Use of mobile phones for chatting, surfing, whats app, playing games and watching videos is strictly not allowed inside the Court Hall when Court Proceedings are in progress. Advocates / Party-in-person / Advocate's Clerks / Peons / Law Interns / Solicitors who wish to use their mobile phones are directed to step out of the Court for using their mobile phones for the above purposes. Mobile phones shall be carried inside the Court Hall strictly in silent mode or switched off mode only.
