IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for the information of the learned members of the Bar and the parties appearing in-person that the **Division Bench presided over by Hon'ble Shri Justice R. I. Chagla and Hon'ble Shri Justice Farhan P. Dubash (Court Room No. 21)** has issued the following directions in respect of :

I] Mentioning matters for urgent circulation :

- 1) Mentioning for circulation of matters is permitted at 11.00 a.m. ONLY.
- 2) No mentioning is permitted at 2.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m.
- 3) Praecipe must disclose :
 - (i) Date of impugned order / cause of action;
 - (ii) Date of filing petition / appeal / application;
 - (iii) Urgency;
 - (iv) Act applicable;
 - (v) Category i.e., Service, Educational Institutions etc.
- 4) No mentioning for circulation is permitted unless there is extreme urgency. Such urgency must be made out orally as well as in the praecipe.
- 5) If urgent circulation is granted but it is found there was in fact no urgency, the Court may impose costs.

II] Matters listed on board are not permitted to be mentioned unless the other side is present.

III] Following allocation of days for the subject-wise category of matters will be henceforth applicable:
