

OFFICE ORDER

As per directions given by the Hon'ble Shri Justice K.R. Shriram in Testamentary Suit No. 10 of 2004 in Testamentary Petition No. 662 of 2003, Advocates and parties appearing in person are hereby informed that as and when Suit is listed for hearing and final disposal, following directions shall be followed :

- (A) Advocates and Parties will coordinate with the Registry of this Court to re-arrange the record in a proper fashion with a running pagination and an index. Preferably a separate compilation, corresponding to that of the advocates, and on white paper should be prepared for use by the Court. If the compilation is in multiple volumes, there should be running paging for the entire record.
- (B) Advocates and Parties to come with :
- (i) Chronology of dates and events;
 - (ii) Bullet points of the submission/arguments;
 - (iii) Index of exhibits containing the date, particulars, exhibit number and through which witness, and

- (iv) If they are relying on any judgments, then mention the proposition for which they rely upon the judgment.

- (v) If certain documents have been taken on file during the cross examination of any witness and they are yet to be received in evidence, a separate list of those documents containing the date, particulars, marking made by the Commissioner and the questions based on which the parties assert the document should be received in evidence.
