

N O T I C E

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for the information of the Learned members of the Bar and the parties appearing in-person at the **Principal Seat at Bombay** that **with effect from 10 August 2026**, the following directions have been issued by the Single Bench presided over by the **Hon'ble Shri. Justice Amit Borkar** :

1. **On every Monday**, Civil Writ Petitions (except matters assigned to other Courts) pertaining to the years 2015 to 2021 shall be taken up.
- 1A. **On every Tuesday**, First Appeals relating to Land Acquisition from the year 2017 onwards shall be taken up.
- 1B. **On every Wednesday to Friday**, matters relating to Arbitration Petitions under Section 9 instituted from the year 2025 onwards and Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall be taken up.
- 1C. **Original Side matters** pertaining to **Land Acquisition** shall be taken up on **the days specifically fixed and listed**, as may be notified by the Court from time to time.
2. Mentioning of matters in open Court shall not be permitted.
3. All praecipes seeking urgent circulation shall be submitted to the Court Sheristedar/Associate in the morning before 11:00 a.m.
4. Every praecipe seeking urgent circulation shall contain:
 - (a) the date of filing of the petition/application; and
 - (b) the precise reason for urgency, which shall not exceed five lines.
5. Any praecipe not containing the aforesaid particulars shall be liable to be rejected.

6. The party seeking urgent circulation shall, on the very day the matter is circulated, forthwith communicate in writing to the opposite side the fact of such circulation and the date on which the matter is proposed to be placed before the Court.

7. Appearances shall be furnished in a duly typed format. No praecipe for speaking to the minutes shall be entertained for correction or insertion of appearances.

8. In all matters pertaining to the Original Side, when the matters are called out for hearing, the learned Advocates appearing for the parties, as well as parties appearing in person, shall keep available physical copies of all pleadings and relevant papers for the purpose of reference and effective conduct of the proceedings.

9. With a view to facilitate expeditious processing of records and effective consideration of petitions filed under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, learned Counsel are requested to furnish the following particulars in a tabular format at the time the matter is called out:
