IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for the information of the learned members of the Bar and the parties appearing in-person at the Principal Seat at Bombay that the Single Bench presided over by the **Hon'ble Shri Justice Milind N. Jadhav** has issued the following directions :

1. In view of sitting list w.e.f. 10.08.2026, it is notified that matters assigned to this Court (Coram: Mr. Milind N. Jadhav, J.) shall be listed and heard as directed herein below on and from 11.08.2026 (The Board for 10.08.2026 shall be published as per the matters listed on that date as it is).

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2. Fresh matters filed for seeking Regular Bail / Quashing will be **auto-listed** within seven days after **final numbering** of the matters on the Circulation Board on the designated day.
3. **At 3:00 p.m.** only urgent and auto-listed matters will be taken up for hearing / listing on the **Circulation Board** on priority on the designated days. Matters on the Daily Board will thereafter be continued after the Circulation Board is over. Old Writ Petitions / Criminal Applications for Quashing and Bail Applications will be given priority amongst the matters which are to be taken up for hearing from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on the '**Daily Board**' in seriatim from 11.08.2026 until further orders. No weekly Board will be published. Board will be published daily. All matters adjourned to future dates by previous Bench shall be restructured as above. For urgent matters, fresh appropriate praecipe be moved or circulation be sought by the parties on the ground of urgency / exigency

considered by the previous Bench while granting such circulation.

4. With regard to matters which may not involve extreme urgency, i.e for regular circulation of Writ Petitions / Criminal Applications for Quashing and Bail Applications, Advocates and parties-in-person are requested/required to submit a Praecipe containing below mentioned information / prescribed format, to the Sheristedar of the Court strictly between **10:45 a.m. to 10:55 a.m.** (latest by 11:00 a.m.). Such matters will be listed on Board as per their turn in seriatim. Praecipe received in any other format shall not be accepted. The dates of circulation will be published on the High Court website on the very day in the evening or on the following day definitely by the Board Department.

7. Strict instructions are given to the Board Department to list the matters pertaining to the assignment of this Court chronologically / as per their turn in seriatim unless otherwise permitted / directed by the Court specifically on and from 11.08.2026 onwards.
8. Advocates / Senior Advocates are requested not to interrupt the Court Proceedings once the Daily Board begins and mention their matters which are on board. **Mentioning of matters at 11:00 a.m., 2:00 p.m. or 3:00 p.m. on any day is strictly not allowed.** This may be noted by the Advocates.

9. Mentioning of matters is strictly not permitted at 11:00 a.m.

Only matters of extreme and grave urgency which cannot wait, can be mentioned by Advocates for urgent circulation at **5:00 p.m.** daily. If it is found that matters are mentioned merely for listing / preponement without any extreme cause or grave urgency to the satisfaction of the Court, the Court will be constrained to levy exemplary / heavy costs on the parties, which may be noted.

10. Advocates are requested to provide their appearances in typed format only and if not given, their names will not be included in the order sheet. It is observed that this is not being followed largely and it results in extreme difficulty to the Department and the Court to decipher the handwriting, names and spellings while passing orders. No Application for speaking to minutes to correct / include appearances will be entertained in such cases.

11. Use of mobile phones for chatting, surfing, WhatsApp, playing games and watching videos is strictly not allowed inside the Court Hall when Court Proceedings are in progress. Advocates /

Senior Advocates / Party-in-person / Advocate's Clerks / Peons / Law Interns / Solicitors and litigants / parties attending Court who wish to use their mobile phones are directed to step out of the Court for using their mobile phones for the above purposes. Mobile phones shall be carried inside the Court Hall strictly in silent mode or switched off mode only. If the mobile phones ring during the Court proceedings, it shall be confiscated as per Rules and handed over to the Prothonotary and Senior Master / Registrar of this Court for further action. Recording of Court proceedings on mobile phones is strictly prohibited. Holding of conferences, seeking instructions from the client while the Court is in session creates disturbance and is therefore prohibited inside the Court Room. Separate seating enclosure is made available for clients / litigants. Advocates shall not encourage clients / litigants to move away from the said enclosure and hold mini-conferences for taking instructions inside the main Court Hall / Room. All such discussions be held strictly outside the Court Hall without disturbing the Court

proceedings.

- 12.** Matters need not be mentioned for continuation of ad-interim relief which is already granted previously and such ad-interim relief granted earlier / existing shall stand continued automatically till the next date of listing in the case of:-

- (a) Non-availability of the Court for judicial work;
- (b) When the Board is discharged due to paucity of time; and
- (c) Matters are not shown on the Board on the scheduled / adjourned dates.

P.S. - If any statement has been made but not recorded then such statement shall also stand continued in view of the matter not having reached due to the above three (3) reasons.
