ABOUT MAIN MEDIATION CENTRE

The Bombay High Court has Main Mediation Centre at Room No.104, first floor, PWD Building, Bombay High Court. The Main Mediation Centre is having panel of trained Mediators for post-litigation cases of High Court of Bombay Principal Seat. There is need of Counsellors also. Therefore, the Hon'ble Main Mediation Monitoring Committee has decided to constitute a panel of 10 Counsellors for pre-litigation and post-litigation matters. This panel will provide psycho-social services to the litigants approaching the High Court in matrimonial disputes and other disputes. The panel will provide services to individuals and couples in distress and promote their overall emotional wellbeing.

THE JOB PROFILE IS AS FOLLOWS:

QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate should have completed M.A. in Counselling/Clinical Psychology alongwith a minimum 2 years' experience of working as a Counsellor. Preference will be given to those candidates who have additional qualifications such as having completed specialized courses in Couple and Family Therapy or demonstrating direct experience of working as a Couple/Family Therapist. Preference will also be given to candidates who have an experience of working in legal settings. Proficiency in English, Hind and Marathi is preferred.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

1. This position will entail working with individuals, children and couples who are currently undergoing matrimonial disputes or any other disputes and pre-litigation matters at Bombay High Court. The Counsellor will provide individual, couples and family counselling and also be responsible for documentation of the work.
2. The Counsellor will be required to do counselling at the counselling rooms of Bombay High Court or at any other place, subject to orders from the Hon'ble High Court or directions of the Main Mediation Centre.
3. The Counsellor will also be responsible for conducting group counselling.
4. Documentation of the work conducted at the Centre is expected.

DURATION: The appointment for the post shall be on purely contractual basis for 1 year which may be renewed in the following year considering effective service of Counsellors. The panel of Counsellors will be revamped from time to time. The Counsellor (part-time) shall work for 3 hours and shall be called as and when the services are required.
